

Tournament Rules

- 1. NO stroke limit per hole in tournament play. Play each hole out.
- 2. Each match is a 9-hole match, keeping score just like during the regular season.
 - 1. The team with the most points in the match wins the match and advances to the next round.
 - 2. Each match must be played as a group (no card-matching).
- 3. All matches must be played on the designated course shown in the bracket (unless changed by the course).
- 4. All matches must be completed before the next scheduled date of play.
 - 1. If a team member cannot play at the scheduled time, they can ask the other team to play the match at a different date and time (get a tee time on the correct course). Notify the League Secretary in advance if you do this.
 - 2. If playing at a different date and time is not agreeable, a DWGL Sub from the current Sub List on the website can be used.
 - 1. Regulars are <u>not</u> available as subs.
 - 3. If a player turns out to be a no-show, the match is played with the players that are there.
 - 1. The player whose teammate doesn't show is considered the A player for the match.
 - 2. The player without an opponent must play to their handicap plus 1 to get all 4 points, handicap plus 2 to get 3 points, above that: 2 points.
- 5. Tie-breaker:
 - 1. The choice of a sudden death playoff by playing extra holes is NOT an option at Yankee Trace.
 - 2. Starting from the last hole played and going backwards, find the first team with a NET birdie (or better) that is not matched by either member on the opposing team.
 - 1. To determine a player's net score on a hole, apply their league handicap to the handicap rankings on the scorecard for that course.
 - 3. If one team has a player with a net birdie on the last hole, but the other team has a player with a net eagle, the team with the net eagle wins.
 - 4. If no net birdies (or better) on the last hole, then you proceed backwards to the next hole, and so on.
- 6. Semi-finals and finals are played on the same date (see bracket for tee times). After completing the semi-final rounds, the two winners play again for the League Championship and the two losers play again for 3rd place.
